10 January - Christmas Tree Collection

From 15:00 to 16:00, a container will be available for all your Christmas trees. You get a raffle ticket and we will see how many trees each one of you will deliver.

New Year's Reception From 16:00 to 18:30, J.C. Beetslaan 134.

Together with Meerlanden, we try to collect all Christmas trees in a single day. This helps reduce litter and avoids unnecessary driving.

The neighborhood council receives a small contribution, allowing us to hand out some nice prizes. But please note: everyone is welcome at the New Year's reception, also without bringing a tree!

Volunteers

Wijkraad SHN consists of a group of volunteers involved in everything happening in the neighborhood. We have divided the tasks so everyone can focus on what they do best and/or enjoy most. Think of contact with municipal authorities, construction projects, traffic and safety, nuisance at collection points, green spaces, the community BBQ and other events. Wanted

We are looking for residents who want to help with:

- Working groups on new construction, traffic, public transport, construction drawings, architecture, etc.
- Political involvement, such as attending council meetings.
- Initiatives to make the neighborhood more "self-reliant" in case of emergencies.

We do this for and with each other, to keep our neighborhood clean, social, pleasant and livable. This depends on good cooperation between neighbors and districts.

Project Details

New construction - Dik Trom School / Wormerstraat

We have good contact with the municipality about this project, but we are genuinely concerned about the nuisance that may arise during construction. Also about the lack of parking spaces once new homes are added and Mevlana expands. The location of the new school and apartments also raises questions. There is no project developer yet, so much remains uncertain. We will keep you informed.

HONK – Het Nieuwe Noord

Construction has now started, and pile-driving has begun. So far, the nuisance seems limited. For the future, we are concerned about the planned bus gate on the Hoofdweg. We fear that Hoofddorp Noord will get much more traffic as a result. Let's all remain critical. Information and complaints about this project: via the BouwApp or HNN@vastbouw.nl

Nuisance at Recycling Points

Many residents are annoyed by bulky waste dumped near the recycling points. This national problem must mainly be solved locally. It often concerns people from the neighborhood – sometimes out of ignorance, sometimes out of convenience.

We want to find a way to encourage residents and businesses to follow the rules.

Unable to dispose of waste correctly? Contact Meerlanden, the municipality, or the district council.

Did you know?

- Meerlanden collects 2 m³ of bulky waste for free per year from your home.
- You can drop off 3 m³ per year for free at the recycling centers (Rijsenhout, Heemstede and Nieuw-Vennep NV for household waste only).
- Recycling points are for private waste (glass, paper, plastic) and NOT for businesses.

Self-Reliance
